Do these for tighter protection

Lock it up

Secure your building against unwanted guests at all times. It's surprisingly easy to find a way in if you know where to look.

Fire protection

Be sure that your fixed fire protection is maintained and in full working order – so that's your automatic fire alarm and sprinkler system.

Monitored intruder systems

Keep your alarm set whenever the building is unoccupied. Ensure it's in good working order and set up a security response to any activation (if you haven't already).

Utilities off and on

Switch off gas, electricity and water supplies
– but make sure that your intruder alarm, fire
alarm and sprinkler system remain operational.

Weekly inspections

Complete random once-weekly inspections to check that your building is empty and not being used for suspicious activity.
